


The main showground area has a useable area of 497,411 square foot or 46,211 metres square. This capacity allows 92,422 total capacity with a 2-metre social distancing capacity of 11,553 persons. Adopting a 12ft grid system will allow persons to safely move around the showground whilst still being able to maintain a 2-metre social distance when passing other people. The 12ft grid system adoption will allow a main showground capacity of 3454 persons at any one time, with an addition 10% tolerance for any equipment that hinder the use of the grid a capacity of 3111 persons will be available for any one day. This will allow clear distancing for exhibitors to enter & exit the ring eliminating exhibitors congregating at entrance or exit points. All judges, stewards & exhibitors are always to wear suitable face coverings that fully cover the nose & mouth area whilst in the ring. Judges are to be seated at their own table with ring stewards seated at either end of their own table. Stewards are to maintain social distancing from each other when conducting their ring duties. All exhibitors are to ensure they always stay socially distanced from fellow exhibitors.
